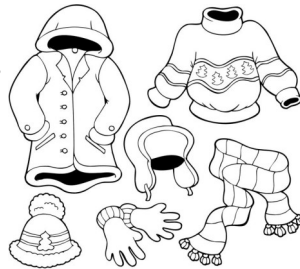
## St. Joseph's Hospital coat and blanket drive

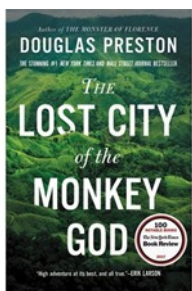
Items needed this year include:
