Who needs them?


- The clothes closet for Drug Endangered Children. Children removed from homes contaminated with methamphetamine are not allowed to take any of their things with them.


Help is Needed: The Altar Guild Group is looking for more people who would be willing to help with setting up communion for Sunday Mornings. Please contact the church office for more information.


made a difference in people's lives. The CFMC is supporting the Soles4Souls project. Please bring your

Book Buddies


